

Craft time

Reinvent the classic paper-and-pencil game of Tic Tac Toe (or Noughts and Crosses as you may know it) by creating a big outdoor version. You can even make it edible!

- 1 Get a flat, smooth piece of wood.
- 2 Draw or paint a 3 x 3 grid on the wood using a ruler.
- 3 Gather a range of objects such as marshmallows, dried fruit or lego and divide according to colour between you and your opponent
- 4 Take it in turns to mark the space in the grid with your objects.
- 5 The player who succeeds in placing three of their objects in a horizontal, vertical or diagonal row wins the game.
- 6 This game helps to teach kids about colours, numbers and patterns.
